Application:	Participants shall hand in their applications in written form by e-mail until Saturday, April 06th 2024 at the latest	
	LATE APPLICATIONS ARE NOT POSSIBLE! Applications received after April 06th shall not be considered! Please only use the official application forms. Alterations and cancellations shall only be made by the Dojo leaders or their representatives until registration deadline on the day of the competition.	
	Participants under 18 years are only allowed to start at Jiyu-Kumite with a signature by their legal guardians. The liability declaration has to be handed over with the payment on Saturday 13 th .	
Mode:	For each individual discipline there have to be at least 3 participants. If there are less participants, they will start at the next higher group-level.	
Kata:	qualifying rounds – by flag decision, Eight or less participants – decision on points;	
Kumite:	Brasilian knock-out system in accordance with S.K.I.E.F. rules.	

All competitions of **kyu championship** directly lead to the finals. The competitions of **Nagai Cup** are divided into qualifying rounds and finals.

- Kumite** All Sanbon- and Kihon Ippon Kumite forms take place in single modus (no Yakusoku)
- Protectors:** Fist protectors are compulsory for Jiyu-Kumite! Only white fist protectors are acceptable (S.K.I.E.F.). Additionally accepted protectors: groin protectors, tooth protectors/gum-shields, breast protectors (women). Dressings, bandages and glasses are not allowed.
- Liability:** Participation in the both championships is at the participants' own risk. The competitors shall therefore insure themselves suitably against any risks! The organizer refuses to accept responsibility for possible injuries.
- Referees:** All referees under consideration are requested to be prepared for being called upon during the championships in order to ensure a smooth procedure of the competitions.
- Obligatory **referee clothing:**
- Navy blue blazer (S.K.I.E.F.)
 - plain grey trousers without cuffs, white shirt/blouse
 - official S.K.I.F.- tie
 - women hair clip with long hair
- Miscellaneous:** Admission free!
The participating Dojo's are requested to bring their Dojo flags.
On Saturday in the evening there will be the possibility to join the restaurant

Additional possibilities of staying overnight:

Overnight accomodation is possible from Friday to saturday and from Saturday to Sunday in a sports hall after prior registration.

Kumite: 2 x Sanbon Kumite (Jodan, Chudan, Mae-Geri)

J2 Boys 12-15 years, 5th to 1st Kyu

Kata: preliminary round: Heian Shodan to Godan

Final: free choice of Heian Kata, Bassai Dai, Kanku Dai, Jion, Enpi

Kumite: Jiyu-Kumite (permission of legal guardian necessary)

M1 Girls 12-15 years, 8th to 6th Kyu

Kata: Heian Shodan to Sandan (Final: free choice of Heian-Kata)

Kumite: 2 x Sanbon Kumite (Jodan, Chudan, Mae-Geri)

M2 Girls 12-15 years, 5th to 1st Kyu

Kata: preliminary round: Heian Shodan to Godan

Final: free choice of Heian Kata and Bassai Dai, Kanku Dai, Enpi or Jion

Kumite: Jiyu Kumite (permission of legal guardian necessary)

NH1 Men 16+ years, 8th to 6th Kyu

Kata: Heian Shodan to Sandan (Final: free choice of Heian Kata)

Kumite: 2 x Sanbon Kumite (Jodan, Chudan, Mae-Geri)

NH2 Men 16+ years, 5th and 4th Kyu

Kata: Heian Shodan to Godan (Final: free choice of Heian Kata)

Kumite: Jiyu Kumite (permission of legal guardian necessary)

NH3 Men, 16 to 29 years, 3rd to 1st Kyu

Kata: 1st round: Heian Shodan to Godan

Kata: 1st round: Heian Shodan to Godan

preliminary Kata: Bassai Dai, Jion, Enpi, Kanku Dai

Final: free choice of Bassai Dai, Jion, Enpi, Kanku Dai

(preliminary Kata and final Kata must be different)

Kumite: Jiyu Kumite (permission of legal guardian necessary)

Team disciplines for men and women until 1st Kyu and 29 years:

MKK	children up to 14 years:	Kata Team (mixed possible)
MKD	Women 15+ years:	Kata Team Women
MKH	Men 15+ years:	Kata Team Men
MD	Women 15+ years, 5th to 1st Kyu:	Kumite Team Women
MH	Men 15+ years, 5th to 1st Kyu:	Kumite Team Men

- a) MD and MH Jiyu-Kumite with 3 starters + 1 substitute
- b) Adults 3rd to 1st Kyu with 30+ years are not allowed, they are participants of Nagai Cup
- c) Per each discipline there are allowed at **maximum 2 Teams** from each Dojo/Country
- d) MD and MH - permission of legal guardian necessary for starters at age 15 to 17
